- Some pupils will understand how the features of the animals help them in the rainforest

Session Outline:

The session introduces what a rainforest is through videos. Then a strange sound is heard, which leads to the story. The story starts in the African rainforest leading to the Asian rainforest and ending with the rainforest in South America. Whilst in each of these rainforests, there is a focus on some of the animals found in the rainforest in a guest to identify the strange sound. With the use of videos, biofacts and interactive activities, key aspects of the animal's biology or behaviour will be looked at. The end of the story concludes with the discovery of the animal that was making the strange sound.
