



Hello

Bears of the Rising Sun














Inside Koi Niwa

There are also fish tanks. A tall one upstairs and a long one downstairs.


The long tank has benches in front of it. I can sit down here and watch the fish.

I can go up the ramp to find the aardvarks sleeping.


They are awake all night so sleep during the day.

Did I like the smell?










The Nature Area
